



The Birkebeiner Legend In the year 1206 a civil war raged in Norway. The infant prince and direct heir to


young prince, later crowned King of Norway, ended the civil war. The Birkebeiners (Birchbarkleggers) got their name from wrapping and tying birch bark around their legs from the knees down, like gaiters. This kept the snow out and protected their legs in battle. 


